### EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 05, s.2021

### AN ORDER CREATING THE DEVOLUTION TRANSITION PLAN COMMITTEE IN THE **MUNICIPALITY OF PANIQUI**

WHEREAS, Section 6. Article x of the Constitution provides that the local government units (LGUs) shall have a just share, as determined by law, in the national taxes which shall be automatically released to them:

WHEREAS, in Mandanas, et. al. v. Executive Secretary, et. al. (GR Nos. 199802 and 208488), the Supreme Court held that all collections of the national taxes, except those accruing to special purpose funds and special allotments for the utilization and development of the national wealth, should be included in the computation of the base of just share of LGUs;

WHEREAS, the substantial increase in the shares of the LGUs from the national taxes will empower the LGUs in providing basic services and facilities to their constituents, and aid them in the effective discharge of other duties and functions devolved to them under Section 17 of RA 7160;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of RA 7160 provides the operative principles of decentralization that shall guide the formulation of policies and measures on local autonomy:

WHEREAS, with the full devolution of the provision of basic services and facilities to the LGUs, national government agencies can assume more strategic and steering functions to address persistent development issues;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Executive Order No. 138 on Full Devolutionof Certain Functions of the Executive Branch to Local Governments, Creation of a Committee on Devolution, and For Other Purposes, mandating all LGUs to prepare their respective devolution transition plans (DTPs);

NOW THEREFORE, I, LEONARDO M. ROXAS, Local Chief Executive of Paniqui, Tarlac, by the power vested in me by the law, do hereby create the Devolution Transition Plan Committee in the Municipality of Paniqui, Tarlac.

Section 1. Composition. The DTP Committee shall be composed as follows:



Section 2. Functions.

- 1. The DTP Committee shall have the following duties and functions:
- 2. Lead and oversee the preparation and implementation of the devolution transition plan/s with the following content, among others;
  - a. State of devolved functions, services and facilities
  - b. Capacity development agenda
  - c. Organizational structure and staffing pattern
  - d. Local revenue forecast and resource mobilization strategy
  - e. Phasing of full assumption of devolved functions and services and the corresponding performance targets for such
- 3. Formulate Capacity Development Agenda based on the assessment framework and guidelines to be issued by the DILG-LGA.
- 4. Evaluate the status and monitor implementation of the DTPs and ensure compliance of various offices/departments;
- 5. Adopt mechanisms to ensure continuous delivery of public services during the transition period to full devolution:
- 6. Formulate communications plan and strategies aligned and complementary to the communications plan formulated and approved by the National Government;
- 7. Ensure that local programs and policies are integrated and coordinated towards a common national goal and shall abide by the policies, standards and strategies.

Section 3. Effectivity.

This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
