EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 07, s.2019

RE-ORGANIZATION OF THE MUNICIPAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCIL (MADAC)

WHEREAS, Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that Local Government Units shall pursue undertaking to improve public morals and maintain peace and order among other equally significant concerns;

WHEREAS, the increasing use of illegal drugs has contributed much to the incidence of heinous crimes, thus, there is an urgent need to address the problem in order to effectively ensure community peace and harmony;

WHEREAS, to combat drug-addiction, DILG Memorandum Circular No. 98-227 dated December 2, 1998 was issued mandating local Government Units (LGUs) to create the Local Anti-Drug Abuse Council;

NOW, THEREFOR, I, LEONARDO M. ROXAS, Municipal Mayor, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order the Reorganization of the Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council;

Section 2. RESPONSIBILITIES. The Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council shall perform the following functions:

- 2. Provide for an effective mechanism for the coordination of existing services and program and those which might developed in the immediate future;
- 3. Provide for a mechanism to obtain fund, volunteers, facilities and technical expertise and;
- 4. Perform other related responsibilities that may be assigned by competent authorities.

Section 3. EFFECTIVITY. This order shall take effect immediately.
