RESOLUTION NO. 078-2010

WHEREAS, Republic Act 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 has empowered each local government unit to create its own sources of revenue through the levy of taxes, fees and charges subject to the limitations imposed therein as doing consistent with the basic policy of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, the aforesaid law further authorizes each local government unit to regulate any business, occupation or practice of profession within its territorial jurisdiction through the issuance of permits and licenses for the purpose of promoting the general welfare of its constituents subject to such minimum terms and conditions as formulated through an appropriate ordinance;

WHEREAS, in accordance in Section 447 of the republic Act 7160, the Sangguniang Bayan as the legislative body of the local government unit shall enact ordinance to regulate activities relative to utilization of lands, building and structures within its jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Dante P. Belarmino, unanimously seconded, RESOLVED, as it is hereby RESOLVED, to require all operators of business establishments doing business within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality of Paniqui, Tarlac to secure a business license plate.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this resolution be enacted into an ordinance to wit;

MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE 2010 - 009

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL OPERATORS OF BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS DOING BUSINESS WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PANIQUI, TARLAC TO SECURE A BUSINESS LICENSE PLATE.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Paniqui, Tarlac in session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. DEFINITION OF TERMS

a. OPERATORS OF BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS – as used in this ordinance shall mean all business operators required under existing laws & appropriate ordinances to secure and/or renew proper business permits and licenses as a prior condition to its operations within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality except those ambulant vendors. magney

- b. BUSINESS LICENSE PLATE as used in this ordinance shall mean an embossed plate similar to the registration plates issued to motor vehicles showing that a particular business operator is a legitimate and duly registered business operating within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality to be secured from the Municipal Treasury Office
- c. VALIDATING STICKERS as used in this ordinance shall mean a legitimate sticker printed by the local government unit showing that the Business License Plate of a particular business operator has been duly renewed for the ensuing fiscal year or every so often as required by existing laws and appropriate ordinance.

SECTION 2. All operators of business establishment operating within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality except those ambulant or itinerant vendors are hereby required to register and secure a Business License Plate upon payment of corresponding fees for the following year or so often from the Municipal Treasury Office.

SECTION 3. The Business License Plate which shall cost THREE HUNDRED FIFTY PESOS (P 350.00) each shall be valid for a period of NINE(9) years from its issuance unless altered, defaced or damaged in such a way that it shall become illegible. Once issued, such Business License Plate shall be validated for the ensuing year and every so often through the issuance of a printed validation sticker which shall cost **SEVENTY FIVE PESOS (P 75.00)** each affixed to such registration plate.

SECTION 4. Upon securing such Business License Plate from the Treasury Office, the business operator shall post and display the same in a conspicuous location within his establishment to be readily seen or viewed by government inspectors in order to facilitate the proper identification of any unauthorized and/or non-registered business establishments which shall enable the government to properly enforce applicable laws and appropriate ordinances.

SECTION 5. That in the event the cost of production of the Business License Plate shall increase, the municipal treasurer shall within fifteen (15) days from notice of such increase cause thru the office of the mayor the immediate adoption of an ordinance providing for such increase provided, however, he may continue collecting and accepting business plate fee at the current/prevailing rate from the applicant/s and the increment (increase) shall be collected upon approval of the ordinance and issuance of the new plate. Provided, further, that the cost of Business License Plate shall remain the same until all plates are disposed/sold.

SECTION 6. Upon its approval, the Municipal Mayor, with due recommendation from the Municipal Treasury Office shall issue appropriate guidelines and implementing rules to ensure the proper implementation of the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 7. Any person found violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction, be punished by imprisonment for a period not exceeding SIX (6) months, or fine not exceeding ONE THOUSAND PESOS (P1,000.00) or both at the discretion of the Court. In the case of corporations, partnerships or associations its President, General Manager or person-in-charge of such establishment liable therefore.

SECTION 8. This ordinance shall take effect upon approval.
