**RESOLUTION NO. 101 - 2008**

WHEREAS, reports of robberies in banks and/or their respective clients, being victimized by lawless elements are once in a while hugging the newspaper headlines;

WHEREAS, police force has some degree of difficulty in resolving the crimes of robbery due to lack of lead in the identity of the perpetrators which could be easily available through images generated by a close circuit cameras;

WHEREAS, presence of closed circuit cameras operating during the office and non-office hours will also serve as deterrent for lawless elements who shall now think twice before conducting a robbery;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Sergio C. Baltazar, properly seconded, RESOLVED as it is hereby RESOLVED, to enact an ordinance requiring the installation and maintenance of Close Circuit Camera (CCTV Surveillance System) in all banks operating within the municipality of Paniqui, Tarlac and requiring penalties for violation thereof;

RESOLVED FURTHER that this resolution be enacted into an ordinance, to wit:

**ORDINANCE NO. 06 - 2008**

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF CLOSED CIRCUIT CAMERAS (CCTV SURVEILLANCE SYSTEM) IN ALL BANKS OPERATING WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF PANIQUI AND REQUIRING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Paniqui, Tarlac that:

SECTION 1. It is hereby required the installation and maintenance of closed circuit cameras (CCTV Surveillance System) in all BANKS operating within the Municipality of Paniqui, Tarlac.

SECTION 2. All BANKS operating within the municipality of Paniqui are hereby required to keep the tapes taken from the operation of the said closed circuit camera for a period of ONE WEEK for future reference in case a robbery occurs inside the establishment or a client becomes the victim of a robbery before and after transacting business with the said financial institutions.

SECTION 3. All banks are hereby given TWO (2) MONTHS from the date of approval of this ordinance to comply with the requirements as contained herein.

SECTION 4. Failure to comply with the provisions of this ordinance would be penalized as follows:

SECTION 5. Creation of Inspection Team.

There is hereby created after the approval of this Ordinance an inspection team to ensure that the provisions of this ordinance are strictly observe, to be composed of the following:

1. Representative from the Office of the Municipal Mayor
2. Representative from the Paniqui Police Station
3. Representative from the Office of the Municipal Engineer;

SECTION 6. Any provision of this Ordinance found to be unconstitutional or contrary to existing laws shall not affect and impair the other provision thereof.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in a newspaper of local circulation
