**RESOLUTION NO. 141 - 2011**

On motion of Councilor Rosauro V. Tayag, unanimously seconded, **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby Resolved, to approve an ordinance that shall regulate and require all cargo/dump trucks hauling landfill materials from quarry sources within the territorial jurisdiction of this municipality, to secure hauling accreditation from the Sangguniang Bayan of Paniqui and shall pay required fees thereof.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that this resolution be enacted into an ordinance, to wit:

**ORDINANCE NO. 2011-012**

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Paniqui, Tarlac, in session assembled that:

**Section 1. Title** - This Ordinance shall be known as: **An ordinance that shall regulate and require all cargo/dump trucks hauling landfill materials from quarry sources within the territorial jurisdiction of this municipality, to secure hauling accreditation from the Sangguniang Bayan of Paniqui and shall pay required fees thereof.**

**Section 2. Definition of Terms** - As used in this Ordinance following terms shall mean:

1. **Cargo/dump Trucks**- is a large motor vehicle designed to transport landfill materials.
2. **Quarry source**- place or site legally permitted by the provincial government of Tarlac for extraction of landfill materials.
3. **Haulers/truckers** – truck operators engage in transporting landfill materials from quarry sources to another location.

**Section 3. Coverage** - This Ordinance shall be applicable to all contractors hauling landfill materials that are traversing along the roads of the municipality of Paniqui.

**Section 4.** It shall be unlawful to all haulers/truckers to operate within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality unless a **HAULING ACCREDITATION** is secured from the Sangguniang Bayan of Paniqui.

**Section 5. Accreditation fees:**

- Road maintenance fee per truckload ..... P 50.00
- Accreditation fee (renewable yearly) ..... P 1,000.00  
(Expires every December 31 of every year)
- Hauling accreditation sticker..... P 100.00  
(renewable along with the SB accreditation)

**Section 6. Hauling accreditation sticker:**

- Size – 5 ½ inches x 8 ½ inches
- Red reflectorized background
- White color reflectorized border, ¼ inch thick
- Black color control number, 1 inch height, upper left
- “2012”(updated yearly) black with white border, 1” ht. upper right
- Municipality of Paniqui official logo, 3” diameter., upper centered
- “PANQUI ACCREDITED” wordings, green with white border, 1 ½ inches ht., lower centered reflectorized.

**Section 7. - Requirements:**

1. Letter of intent address to the traffic management council/accreditation board
2. Truck OR and CR
3. Hauling contract
4. DTI / SEC registration
5. Business Permit
6. Certificate of Undertaking (dust/dirt road clearing- sweeping and water spraying)

**Section 8. TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT COUNCIL – The Traffic Management Council is hereby created to be composed of the following:**

- Municipal Mayor - Chairman
  - Committee chairman of Transportation - Vice chairman
  - Committee chairman of Peace and Order - member
  - Chief of Police – Paniqui Police Station - member
  - Paniqui Municipal Engineer - member
  - Paniqui Municipal Treasurer - member
- Serves as accreditation board and submit necessary recommendation to the Sangguniang Bayan for Legislative provision.
  - Create a taskforce:
    - that shall monitor and implement provision of this ordinance;
    - That shall assist law enforcer in regulating traffic and other pertinent ordinances in this municipality

**Section 9. Implementing Agency:**

- a. Municipal Engineer's Office;
- b. Municipal Planning and Development Office;
- c. Municipal Treasury Office.

**Section 10. Penal Provision – The following penalties shall be imposed to any or all violators of this Ordinance:**

1. For First Offense - P 2,000.00;
2. For Second Offense - P 3,500.00;
3. For third offense - P 5,000.00 and the absolute perpetual disqualification to conduct business in the municipality as mention in this Ordinance.

**Section 11. Repealing Clause – All local ordinances, rules and regulations inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed, modified or amended accordingly.**



**Section 12. Separability Clause** - If any provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional and or illegal, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected by such declaration and shall therefore, be in full force and effect.

**Section 13. Effectivity Clause** - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon satisfaction of its required publication for three consecutive issues in a newspaper of general circulation in the MUNICIPALITY and the posting of the same in conspicuous places of the municipal Hall.
