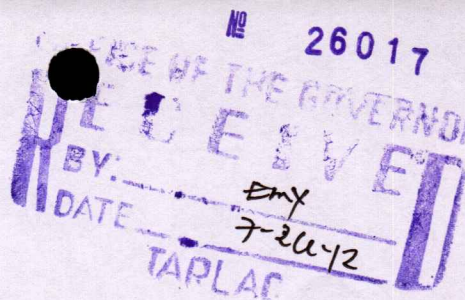

RESOLUTION NO. 117-2012

On motion of Councilor Rosauro V. Tayag, unanimously seconded, **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to approved and adopt an ordinance *prohibiting all trucks hauling landfill materials, sand, gravel, rice hash, saw dust and other quarry materials without full cover on its cargoes from plying within the territorial jurisdiction of the municipality of Paniqui, Tarlac;*

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this resolution be enacted into an ordinance to wit;

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-004

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBIRING ALL TRUCKS HAULING LANDFILL MATERIALS, SAND, GRAVEL, RICE HALS, SAW DUST AND OTHER QUARRY MATERIALS WIHTOUT FULL COVER ON ITS CARGOES FROM PLYING WIHTIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF PANIQUI, TARLAC.

Be it ordained by the Sangguniang Bayan of Paniqui, Tarlac, that:

SECTION I. RATIONALE: The sense of this Ordinance is to protect our constituents, pedestrians, and motorist from danger and health hazards pose when the sand, gravel and other quarry resources loaded in the truck if not securely covered will spill overboard.

SECTION II. SCOPE. All truck drivers driving cargo trucks plying within the jurisdiction of the Municipality of Paniqui, Tarlac hauling sand, gravel and other quarry materials shall be required to securely cover their cargoes with canvas, tarpaulin, and etc.

SECTION III. DEFINITION OF TERMS. The following terms used in this ordinance shall have the following meaning:

- a.) canvas- a strong coarse cloth of unbleached hemp
- b.) gravel- means particles of rock at 75mm sizes and up
- c.) plying- traveling regularly to and from or between places
- d.) quarry materials - any common stone or other common mineral substances such as but not restricted to rocks, limestone, silica, and phosphate.
- e.) sand- a particle of rocks that is 2mm in sizes
- g.) tarpaulin- a waterproof canvas;
- h.) truck- an open container on wheels or vehicle for transporting heavy loads;

SECTION IV. ENFORCEMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION. The Municipal Mayor through the Municipal Treasurer, Barangay Council and the duly deputized Traffic Enforcers with the assistance of the Philippine National Police shall enforce this Ordinance.

SECTION V. PENAL CLAUSE. Any person who violates this ordinance shall be fined

- a) First violation- a compromise penalty of One thousand Pesos (P1,000.00).
- b) Second violation- a compromise penalty of One Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Pesos (P1,750.00).
- c) Third and subsequent violation- a compromise penalty of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (2,500.00) or cancellation of Hauling Accreditation.


SECTION VI. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE. The provision of this Ordinance are hereby declared separable. If any clause, sentence, provision, or section hereof, or its application to any circumstances should be declared invalid, such invalidation shall not affect the other provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION VII. REPEALING CLAUSE. All other Ordinances, rules, and regulation inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby repealed and amended accordingly.


SECTION VIII. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval and ten (10) days after its publication.


