RESOLUTION NO. 091-s2019

“A RESOLUTION ADOPTING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 11036 AN ACT ESTABLISHING A NATIONAL MENTAL HEALTH POLICY FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENHANCING THE DELIVERY OF INTEGRATED MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES, PROMOTING AND PROTECTING THE RIGHTS OF PERSONS UTILIZING PSYCHOSOCIAL HEALTH SERVICES, APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR AND OTHER PURPOSES, ALSO KNOWN AS “*MENTAL HEALTH ACT*”.

WHEREAS, the state affirms the basic right of all Filipinos to mental health as well as the fundamental rights of people who require mental health services.


WHEREAS, the state commits itself to promoting the well-being of people by ensuring that; mental health is valued, promoted and protected; mental health conditions are treated and prevented; timely, affordable, high quality, and culturally-appropriate mental health case is made available to the public; mental health service are free from coercion and accountable to the service users; and persons affected by mental health conditions are able to exercise the full range of human rights, and participate fully in society and at work free from stigmatization and discrimination.

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of **Councilor Felomina F. Bravo**, unanimously seconded, RESOLVED, as it is hereby Resolved, to adopt ***Republic Act No. 11036, An Act Establishing a National Mental Health Policy for the Purpose of Enhancing the Delivery of Integrated Mental Health Services, Promoting and Protecting the Rights of Persons Utilizing Psychosocial Health Services, Appropriating Funds Therefor and Other Purposes*** also known as “*MENTAL HEALTH ACT*”.
