WHEREAS, the 2019 AIP was reviewed by this Council pursuant to Joint Memorandum Circular No. 2011-1, of the DILG and DBM, "Guidelines on the Appropriation and Utilization of the 20% IRA for Development Projects";

WHEREAS, this AIP is firmly anchored and address the requirements of National Scorecards such as 2019 Seal of Good Local Governance (SGLG) and Climate and Disaster Risk Assessment (CDRA);

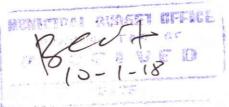


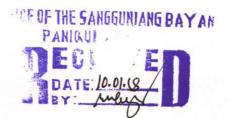

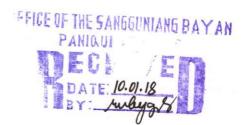
